## INTRODUCTION

In the Bible we find promises from God to help us be encouraged in our lives. God does not promise that we will live a life that is trouble free. On the contrary, He tells us that we will have troubles and trials (John 16:33, 2 Timothy 3:12). The Holy Bible is filled with promises from God to help us survive in this lost and dying world. Consider this...We are all terminal. We are all mortal and someday will die. That is a fact. God wants us to live a life full of peace and joy (John 14:27, John 15:11) even through our troubled times. We also need to realize that God wants His promises to be for everyone, but sadly, they are not. God's promises are for His children, those who have out their faith in Jesus Christ (2 Timothy 3:14-17, Ephesians 1:13). If you have not yet trusted in Him, here's how:

### **You must realize your need for a Savior**

*1 John 1:8-9, Romans 3:23, Romans 6:23, Romans 5:8*

### **You must believe that Jesus lived, died and rose again for you!**

*John 3:16, Romans 4:25, 1 Corinthians 15:3-4*

### **You must confess that Jesus is Lord.**

*Romans 10:9-10, Romans 10:13*

If you are tired of trying to live this life in your own power, have come to the end of yourself and are ready to put your faith in the one true God, Jesus Christ, simply pray a prayer like this one:

***Dear God, I know that I am a sinner. Please forgive me of my sins. I believe Jesus died and rose again for me. Thank you for being my Lord and Savior. In Jesus' name I pray, Amen.***

If you prayed this prayer and meant it from your heart, congratulations, you are now saved (a child of God!) Remember, God wants a relationship with you and He wants to hear from you (Philippians 4:6). Try to visualize yourself climbing into the lap of your merciful Heavenly Father who loves you unconditionally, so much that He sent His Son to die for you. He wants you to pour your most inner thoughts out to Him and share your true heart with Him. Allow your Heavenly Father's power to work in your life and bring healing! He can restore peace and joy to your life.

I hope the promises that follow will be a blessing and an encouragement to you during times of trials and uncertainty.

Is not the life more than meat, and the body than raiment?(26) Behold the fowls of the air: for they sow not, neither do they reap, nor gather into barns; yet your heavenly Father feedeth them. Are ye not much better than they?(27) Which of you by taking thought can add one cubit unto his stature?(28) And why take ye thought for raiment? Consider the lilies of the field, how they grow; they toil not, neither do they spin:(29) And yet I say unto you, That even Solomon in all his glory was not arrayed like one of these.(30) Wherefore, if God so clothe the grass of the field, which today is, and tomorrow is cast into the oven, *shall he* not much more *clothe* you, O ye of little faith?(31) Therefore take no thought, saying, What shall we eat? or, What shall we drink? or, Wherewithal shall we be clothed?(32) (For after all these things do the Gentiles seek:) for your heavenly Father knoweth that ye have need of all these things.(33) But seek ye first the kingdom of God, and his righteousness; and all these things shall be added unto you.(34) Take therefore no thought for the morrow: for the morrow shall take thought for the things of itself. Sufficient unto the day is the evil thereof.

Psalm 23:1-6

- (1) A Psalm of David. The LORD is my shepherd; I shall not want.(2) He maketh me to lie down in green pastures: he leadeth me beside the still waters.(3) He restoreth my soul: he leadeth me in the paths of righteousness for his name's sake.(4) Yea, though I walk through the valley of the shadow of death, I will fear no evil: for thou *art* with me; thy rod and thy staff they comfort me.(5) Thou preparest a table before me in the presence of mine enemies: thou anointest my head with oil; my cup runneth over.(6) Surely goodness and mercy shall follow me all the days of my life: and I will dwell in the house of the LORD forever.

Romans 14:17-19

(17) For the kingdom of God is not meat and drink; but righteousness, and peace, and joy in the Holy Ghost.(18) For he that in these things serveth Christ *is* acceptable to God, and approved of men.(19) Let us therefore follow after the things which make for peace, and things wherewith one may edify another.

2Corinthians 13:11

Finally, brethren, farewell. Be perfect, be of good comfort, be of one mind, live in peace; and the God of love and peace shall be with you.

Romans 15:13

Now the God of hope fill you with all joy and peace in believing, that ye may abound in hope, through the power of the Holy Ghost.

(28) I came forth from the Father, and am come into the world: again, I leave the world, and go to the Father.(29) His disciples said unto him, Lo, now speakest thou plainly, and speakest no proverb.(30) Now are we sure that thou knowest all things, and needest not that any man should ask thee: by this we believe that thou camest forth from God.(31) Jesus answered them, Do ye now believe?(32) Behold, the hour cometh, yea, is now come, that ye shall be scattered, every man to his own, and shall leave me alone: and yet I am not alone, because the Father is with me.(33) These things I have spoken unto you, that in me ye might have peace. Wait on the LORD: be of good courage, and he shall strengthen thine heart: wait, I say, on the LORD.

Psalm 33:20-22

(20) Our soul waiteth for the LORD: he *is* our help and our shield.(21) For our heart shall rejoice in him, because we have trusted in his holy name.(22) Let thy mercy, O LORD, be upon us, according as we hope in thee.

Mark 9:23

Jesus said unto him, If thou canst believe, all things *are* possible to him that believeth.

Romans 8:26-28

(26) Likewise the Spirit also helpeth our infirmities: for we know not what we should pray for as we ought: but the Spirit itself maketh intercession for us with groanings which cannot be uttered.(27) And he that searcheth the hearts knoweth what is the mind of the Spirit, because he maketh intercession for the saints according to *the will of God*.(28) And we know that all things work together for good to them that love God, to them who are the called according to *his* purpose.

Matthew 14:30-33

(30) But when he saw the wind boisterous, he was afraid; and beginning to sink, he cried, saying, Lord, save me.(31) And immediately Jesus stretched forth *his* hand, and caught him, and said unto him, O thou of little faith, wherefore didst thou doubt?(32) And when they were come into the ship, the wind ceased.(33) Then they that were in the ship came and worshiped him, saying, Of a truth thou art the Son of God.

Matthew 14:34-36

(34) And when they were gone over, they came into the land of Gennesaret.(35) And when the men of that place had knowledge of him, they sent out into all that country round about, and brought unto him all that were diseased;(36) And besought him that they might only touch the hem of his garment: and as many as touched were made perfectly whole.

James 5:11

Behold, we count them happy which endure. Ye have heard of the patience of Job, and have seen the end of the Lord; that the Lord is very pitiful, and of tender mercy.

James 5:13-16

Is any among you afflicted? let him pray. Is any merry? let him sing psalms. (14) Is any sick among you? let him call for the elders of the church; and let them pray over him, anointing him with oil in the name of the Lord: (15) And the prayer of faith shall save the sick, and the Lord shall raise him up; and if he have committed sins, they shall be forgiven him. (16) Confess *your* faults one to another, and pray one for another, that ye may be healed. The effectual fervent prayer of a righteous man availeth much.

(2) Bless the LORD, O my soul, and forget not all his benefits: (3) Who forgiveth all thine iniquities; who healeth all thy diseases; (4) Who redeemeth thy life from destruction; who crowneth thee with lovingkindness and tender mercies; (5) Who satisfieth thy mouth with good *things*; *so that* thy youth is renewed like the eagle's.

Father, I need strength...

Ephesians 3:14-21

For this cause I bow my knees unto the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, (15) Of whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named, (16) That he would grant you, according to the riches of his glory, to be strengthened with might by his Spirit in the inner man; (17) That Christ may dwell in your hearts by faith; that ye, being rooted and grounded in love, (18) May be able to comprehend with all saints what is the breadth, and length, and depth, and height; (19) And to know the love of Christ, which passeth knowledge, that ye might be filled with all the fullness of God. (20) Now unto him that is able to do exceeding abundantly above all that we ask or think, according to the power that worketh in us, (21) Unto him *be* glory in the church by Christ Jesus throughout all ages, world without end. Amen.

Colossians 1:9-11

For this cause we also, since the day we heard *it*, do not cease to pray for you, and to desire that ye might be filled with the knowledge of his will in all wisdom and spiritual understanding; (10) That ye might walk worthy of the Lord unto all pleasing, being fruitful in every good work, and increasing in the knowledge of God; (11) Strengthened with all might, according to his glorious power, unto all patience and longsuffering with joyfulness;

Isaiah 40:31

But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew *their* strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; *and* they shall walk, and not faint.

Not that I speak in respect of want: for I have learned, in whatsoever state I am, *therewith* to be content. (12) I know both how to be abased, and I know how to abound: every where and in all things I am instructed both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. (13) I can do all things through Christ which strengtheneth me.

Isaiah 41:10-13

Fear thou not; for I *am* with thee: be not dismayed; for I *am* thy God: I will strengthen thee; yea, I will help thee; yea, I will uphold thee with the right hand of my righteousness. (11) Behold, all they that were incensed against thee shall be ashamed and confounded: they shall be as nothing; and they that strive with thee shall perish. (12) Thou shalt seek them, and shalt not find them, *even* them that contended with thee: they that war against thee shall be as nothing, and as a thing of naught. (13) For I the LORD thy God will hold thy right hand, saying unto thee, Fear not; I will help thee.

Isaiah 40:28-31

Hast thou not known? hast thou not heard, *that* the everlasting God, the LORD, the Creator of the ends of the earth, fainteth not, neither is weary? *there is* no searching of his understanding. (29) He giveth power to the faint; and to *them that have* no might he increaseth strength. (30) Even the youths shall faint and be weary, and the young men shall utterly fall: (31) But they that wait upon the LORD shall renew *their* strength; they shall mount up with wings as eagles; they shall run, and not be weary; *and* they shall walk, and not faint.

Psalms 18:1-2

To the chief Musician, *A Psalm* of David, the servant of the LORD, who spoke unto the LORD the words of this song in the day *that* the LORD delivered him from the hand of all his enemies, and from the hand of Saul: And he said, I will love thee, O LORD, my strength. (2) The LORD *is* my rock, and my fortress, and my deliverer; my God, my strength, in whom I will trust; my buckler, and the horn of my salvation, *and* my high tower.

Ephesians 6:10-18

Finally, my brethren, be strong in the Lord, and in the power of his might. (11) Put on the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to stand against the wiles of the devil. (12) For we wrestle not against flesh and blood, but against principalities, against powers, against the rulers of the darkness of this world, against spiritual wickedness in high *places*. (13) Wherefore take unto you the whole armor of God, that ye may be able to withstand in the evil day, and having done all, to stand. (14) Stand therefore, having your loins girt about with truth, and having on the breastplate of righteousness; (15) And your feet shod with the preparation of the gospel of peace; (16) Above all, taking the shield of faith, wherewith ye shall be able to quench all the fiery darts of the wicked. (17) And take the helmet of salvation, and the sword of the Spirit, which is the word of God: (18) Praying always with all prayer and supplication in the Spirit, and watching thereunto with all perseverance and supplication for all saints;

Nehemiah 8:10

Then he said unto them, Go your way, eat the fat, and drink the sweet, and send portions unto them for whom nothing is prepared: for *this* day is holy unto our Lord: neither be ye sorry; for the joy of the LORD is your strength.

Lamentations 3:21-26

This I recall to my mind, therefore have I hope. (22) *It is of the LORD's mercies that we are not consumed, because his compassions fail not.* (23) *They are new every morning: great is thy faithfulness.* (24) *The LORD is my portion, saith my soul; therefore will I hope in him.* (25) *The LORD is good unto them that wait for him, to the soul that seeketh him.* (26) *It is good that a man should both hope and quietly wait for the salvation of the LORD.*

Isaiah 55:8-13

For my thoughts *are* not your thoughts, neither *are* your ways my ways, saith the LORD. (9) For *as* the heavens are higher than the earth, so are my ways higher than your ways, and my thoughts than your thoughts. (10) For *as* the rain cometh down, and the snow from heaven, and returneth not thither, but watereth the earth, and maketh it bring forth and bud, that it may give seed to the sower, and bread to the eater: (11) So shall my word be that goeth forth out of my mouth: it shall not return unto me void, but it shall accomplish that which I please, and it shall prosper *in the thing* whereto I sent it. (12) For ye shall go out with joy, and be led forth with peace: the mountains and the hills shall break forth before you into singing, and all the trees of the field shall clap *their* hands. (13) Instead of the thorn shall come up the fir tree, and instead of the brier shall come up the myrtle tree: and it shall be to the LORD for a name, for an everlasting sign *that* shall not be cut off.

Psalms 36:5

Thy mercy, O LORD, *is* in the heavens; *and* thy faithfulness *reacheth* unto the clouds.

Deuteronomy 7:9

Know therefore that the LORD thy God, he *is* God, the faithful God, which keepeth covenant and mercy with them that love him and keep his commandments to a thousand generations;

1 Thessalonians 5:24

Faithful *is* he that calleth you, who also will do *it*.

Hebrews 13:5-6

*Let your conversation be* without covetousness; *and be* content with such things as ye have: for he hath said, I will never leave thee, nor forsake thee. (6) So that we may boldly say, The Lord *is* my helper, and I will not fear what man shall do unto me.

2 Thessalonians 3:3

But the Lord *is* faithful, who shall establish you, and keep *you* from evil.

1 Corinthians 10:13

There hath no temptation taken you but such as is common to man: but God *is* faithful, who will not suffer you to be tempted above that ye are able; but will with the temptation also make a way to escape, that ye may be able to bear *it*.

1 Corinthians 1:9

God *is* faithful, by whom ye were called unto the fellowship of his Son Jesus Christ our Lord.

Psalms 91:1-16

He that dwelleth in the secret place of the most High shall abide under the shadow of the Almighty. (2) I will say of the LORD, *He is* my refuge and my fortress: my God; in him will I trust. (3) Surely he shall deliver thee from the snare of the fowler, *and* from the noisome pestilence. (4) He shall cover thee with his feathers, and under his wings shalt thou trust: his truth *shall be thy* shield and buckler. (5) Thou shalt not be afraid for the terror by night; *nor* for the arrow *that* flieth by day; (6) *Nor* for the pestilence *that* walketh in darkness; *nor* for the destruction *that* wasteth at noonday. (7) A thousand shall fall at thy side, and ten thousand at thy right hand; *but* it shall not come nigh thee. (8) Only with thine eyes shalt thou behold and see the reward of the wicked. (9) Because thou hast made the LORD, *which is* my refuge, *even* the most High, thy habitation; (10) There shall no evil befall thee, neither shall any plague come nigh thy dwelling. (11) For he shall give his angels charge over thee, to keep thee in all thy ways. (12) They shall bear thee up in *their* hands, lest thou dash thy foot against a stone. (13) Thou shalt tread upon the lion and adder: the young lion and the dragon shalt thou trample under feet (14) Because he hath set his love upon me, therefore will I deliver him: I will set him on high, because he hath known my name. (15) He shall call upon me, and I will answer him: I *will be* with him in trouble; I will deliver him, and honor him. (16) With long life will I satisfy him, and show him my salvation.

Proverbs 3:5-6

Trust in the LORD with all thine heart; and lean not unto thine own understanding. (6) In all thy ways acknowledge him, and he shall direct thy paths.

Isaiah 26:3-4

Thou wilt keep *him* in perfect peace, *whose* mind *is* stayed *on thee*: because he trusteth in thee. (4) Trust ye in the LORD forever: for in the LORD JEHOVAH *is* everlasting strength:

Isaiah 50:10

Who *is* among you that feareth the LORD, that obeyeth the voice of his servant, that walketh *in* darkness, and hath no light? let him trust in the name of the LORD, and stay upon his God.

Nahum 1:7

The LORD *is* good, a stronghold in the day of trouble; and he knoweth them that trust in him.

Father, I will praise you...

Psalms 18:3

I will call upon the LORD, *who is worthy* to be praised: so shall I be saved from mine enemies.

Psalms 56:10-12

In God will I praise *his* word: in the LORD will I praise *his* word. (11) In God have I put my trust: I will not be afraid what man can do unto me. (12) Thy vows *are* upon me, O God: I will render praises unto thee.

Psalms 27:6

And now shall mine head be lifted up above mine enemies round about me: therefore will I offer in his tabernacle sacrifices of joy; I will sing, yea, I will sing praises unto the LORD.

Psalms 147:1

Praise ye the LORD: for *it is* good to sing praises unto our God; for *it is* pleasant; *and* praise is comely.

Psalms 47:1-9

To the chief Musician, A Psalm for the sons of Korah. O clap your hands, all ye people; shout unto God with the voice of triumph. (2) For the LORD most high *is* terrible; *he is* a great King over all the earth. (3) He shall subdue the people under us, and the nations under our feet. (4) He shall choose our inheritance for us, the excellency of Jacob whom he loved. Selah. (5) God is gone up with a shout, the LORD with the sound of a trumpet. (6) Sing praises to God, sing praises: sing praises unto our King, sing praises. (7) For God *is* the King of all the earth: sing ye praises with understanding. (8) God reigneth over the heathen: God sitteth upon the throne of his holiness. (9) The princes of the people are gathered together, *even* the people of the God of Abraham: for the shields of the earth *belong* unto God: he is greatly exalted.

Psalms 48:1

A Song *and* Psalm for the sons of Korah. Great *is* the LORD, and greatly to be praised in the city of our God, *in* the mountain of his holiness.

Psalms 92:1

A Psalm *or* Song for the sabbath day. *It is* a good *thing* to give thanks unto the LORD, and to sing praises unto thy name, O most High:

Psalms 96:1-4

O sing unto the LORD a new song: sing unto the LORD, all the earth. (2) Sing unto the LORD, bless his name; show forth his salvation from day to day. (3) Declare his glory among the heathen, his wonders among all people. (4) For the LORD *is* great, and greatly to be praised: he *is* to be feared above all gods.

Ephesians 5:18-20

And be not drunk with wine, wherein is excess; but be filled with the Spirit; (19) Speaking to yourselves in psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing and making melody in your heart to the Lord; (20) Giving thanks always for all things unto God and the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ;

Hebrews 11:6

But without faith *it is* impossible to please *him*: for he that cometh to God must believe that he is, and *that* he is a rewarder of them that diligently seek him.

Psalms 109:26-31

Help me, O LORD my God: O save me according to thy mercy: (27) That they may know that this *is* thy hand; *that* thou, LORD, hast done it. (28) Let them curse, but bless thou: when they arise, let them be ashamed; but let thy servant rejoice. (29) Let mine adversaries be clothed with shame, and let them cover themselves with their own confusion, as with a mantle. (30) I will greatly praise the LORD with my mouth; yea, I will praise him among the multitude. (31) For he shall stand at the right hand of the poor, to save *him* from those that condemn his soul.

Psalms 149:1-6

Praise ye the LORD. Sing unto the LORD a new song, *and* his praise in the congregation of saints. (2) Let Israel rejoice in him that made him: let the children of Zion be joyful in their King. (3) Let them praise his name in the dance: let them sing praises unto him with the timbrel and harp. (4) For the LORD taketh pleasure in his people: he will beautify the meek with salvation. (5) Let the saints be joyful in glory: let them sing aloud upon their beds. (6) *Let* the high *praises* of God *be* in their mouth, and a twoedged sword in their hand.

Notes/other verses:
